Children's Summer Reading Program Guidelines

BUILD A BETTER *World*

WHO?

All children from birth to those entering 6th grade for the 2017-2018 school year may participate in the Children's Summer Reading Program. Parents – if your child(ren) aren't reading yet, don't worry! Reading to your child counts and we encourage you to read to your children as often as possible.

WHEN?

The Children's Summer Reading Program runs **Monday, June 5 through Saturday, July 22.**

HOW?

There are 7 Bingo boards, one for each week of the Summer Reading Program. Get Bingo in any direction and then bring it back to the library to get your next Bingo board.

Once you complete 4 Bingo boards, you'll earn a pass to the Summer Reading Bookstore! Complete all 7 Bingo boards and you'll earn another pass to the Summer Reading Bookstore! *That's two free books!* The Summer Reading Bookstore will be open starting Monday, July 24 through Saturday, August 5. **Make sure you keep your bookstore passes safe! Lost Bookstore Passes will NOT be replaced!**
